The role will include the booking and coordinating of batyr@uni programs, alongside supporting the volunteer group of students (batyr@ANU Exec) to deliver events, initiatives and campaigns on campus. The university program at ANU is aimed at reducing stigma and increasing help seeking behaviour for young people and promoting the message that it's ok to not be ok. The role will be pivotal in nurturing and developing batyr's relationships with key stakeholders within the university and to the success of the partnership more broadly. This role will assist in the direction of batyr's core university program at ANU, identifying needs and helping the team continue to improve how we do things at batyr's partner Uni's.

The University Program Coordinator (ANU) will report directly to the Regional Team Leader (QLD/ACT).

key responsibilities

- Drive the recruitment, training and ongoing support of the batyr Student Executive Team by working within the batyr University Program framework
- Provide advice and feedback to the Regional Team Leader (QLD/ACT) around what is tracking well and areas of improvement for the batyr program at ANU
- Key stakeholder management within the University partnership. Working closely with the University structures, including faculties, union, units, accommodation services, counseling services and students
- Assist the Being Herd team in the recruitment of students for the Being Herd (speaker training) workshops
- Provide reports and feedback to University contacts and stakeholders ensuring succesful implementation of the key deliverables outlined in batyr/ANU agreement
- Attend and/or present at workshops, meetings, forums & conferences relating to the program and batyr
- Additional projects as required by the Regional Team Leader
- Continued collaborative and effective teamwork with University stakeholders; the Regional Team Leader, the QLD/ACT team, the batyr@uni team and the wider batyr team.
